SESSION OF BEVERLY HEIGHTS CHURCH, et al. v. PRESBYTERY OF THE ALLEGHENIES

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

[March 22, 2024]

Before this commission is a complaint filed by the session of Beverly Heights Church in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and Teaching Elder Nate Devlin (jointly, the "Complainant") against the Presbytery of the Alleghenies (the "Respondent"). Pursuant to section D.14-8.A.3 of the *Book of Order*, the Complainant is ordered to provide a more definite statement of the grounds on which relief may be granted. The Complainant shall also state with particularity the relief being requested. The statement shall be provided to this commission in writing by April 22, 2024. The Complainant shall further provide a copy of the statement to the Respondent promptly upon filing. Failure to comply with this order shall be grounds for dismissal of the complaint.
