EPC PASTORAL RESIDENCY PROGRAM

A full-orbed preparation for ordained ministry in the EPC is built on the following priorities:

Academic Preparation

• The academic standard for ordination is a Master of Divinity from an accredited Seminary.

Character Formation

 Expectations of behavior are modeled and lived out in community in an apprenticeship with trained Mentor-Pastors.

Practical Experience

 The Ministerial Vocation Committee provides a template of practical competencies and a list of training competencies to Mentor-Pastors. This training will occur during a twelve-, eighteen-, or twenty-four-month apprenticeship prior to the candidate's ordination.
