Founded in 1982, Diamondhead Community Church began as a gathering of Christ-followers in the new community of Diamondhead. From the start—and continuing today—we have drawn people from many denominational backgrounds, creating a diverse and welcoming fellowship united in Christ. In 2020, we left the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) amid its liberal shift to remain faithful to God’s inerrant Word in all matters of faith and life. By joining the Evangelical Presbyterian Church (EPC), we affirmed our obedience to Jesus Christ as our only and sovereign Lord.

Today, Diamondhead Community Church strives to be that church—a place where people from all denominations, backgrounds, and even those still seeking or uncertain in their faith feel welcomed and loved. We are growing through Bible-based preaching, heartfelt worship, and a caring community of believers.
