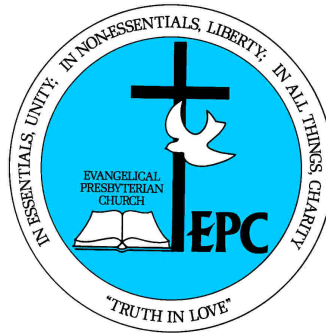


FOREST HILLS PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, EPC
