
## FOREST HILLS PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, EPC

- Steer the congregation into a biblically-grounded course for growth and mission.

#### Church Administration:


- Oversee and manage the day-to-day operations of the church, including staff, budget, and facilities, in conjunction with the Session, as prescribed by the Book of Order.
- Collaborate with church staff and leadership teams to execute and improve church programs and events, in conjunction with the church's Session and committees.
- Ensure compliance with Evangelical Presbyterian Church standards and regulations.
- Faithfully represent the congregation in community organizations, Presbytery meetings
  & activities, and General Assembly.

#### Shepherding the Flock:

- Lead by example and model Christian values and behavior.
- Foster community and unity within the congregation and the community at large.
- Listen to, respect, and love your people, beginning with those entrusted to your pastoral care.
- Equip and empower church leaders and volunteers to fulfill their roles effectively, utilizing their gifts, talents, and abilities for the glory of God.
