Position Overview:

This full-time position is for a visionary spiritual leader to guide and shepherd Mountville Presbyterian Church into future ministry. This person will equip dedicated lay leaders in accordance with God's will towards gospel growth in lives of the church members and mission community (Eph 4:11-12). This position requires a deeply devoted heart for God, his people, and the lost ones in the world that Christ came to save (1 Tim 1:1-5).

Position Responsibilities:

Worship & Sacraments

- Plan and execute Sunday worship services (Liturgy, Scripture, Songs, Prayers, etc.)
- Administer sacraments (including shut-ins)
- Perform Weddings and Funerals

Leadership & Oversight

- Moderate session, including the discipleship and spiritual equipping of the leadership
- In conjunction with session, provide oversight for all boards, lay leaders, and committees
- Discern God's will for the overall direction of his church
- Participate in and represent the church to the Presbytery and the General Assembly

Pastoral Care

- Exercise visitation and pastoral care for ailing, grieved, or troubled members
- Provide counseling for members where appropriate (including pre-marital counseling)
- Pray regularly for the church members

Outreach & Development

- In conjunction with Neighborhood and Mission Committees, lead the church in mission and outreach
- Lead New Membership and Confirmation Classes
- Maintain good reputation and activity within the surrounding community
- Provide Biblical education in conjunction with Christian Education Committee

Professional Qualifications:

- Ordained or eligible to be ordained in The Evangelical Presbyterian Church (EPC)
- Seminary graduate minimally required; M Div preferred

Personal Qualifications:

- A personal, growing relationship with Jesus Christ as evidenced by humility, integrity, and maturity in speech and conduct as outlined in 1 Tim 3:1-7 & Titus 1:6-9
- A commitment to the unity, purity, and peace of the church
- A commitment to integrate church life and family life in a healthy way for the mutual benefit of both
