THE LORD'S FAITHFULNESS THROUGH THE YEARS

1985

Granted status as a Church.

1981

Presbytery asked Germantown Pres to sponsor a new church in the Germantown area. Seven families volunteered and met in individual homes, until mid-year when they began to meet in the Bodine School.

1986

Groundbreaking began at 8816 Poplar Pike.

1989

Moved into our current building at 8816 Poplar Pike.

1998

Began offering two styles of worship – Community and Traditional. Community, our take on a contemporary service, has varied in time and format over the years, while traditional remained consistent.

1999

First short-term international Mission Trip to Bolivia commenced. Since then, teams have been deployed on trips to Cuba, Ethiopia, Mexico, and Brazil.

2000

First addition to the facility, a wing for children's classrooms, nursery, and administrative space, is dedicated.

2007

Second addition to the facility, a multipurpose room with industrial kitchen named Faith Hall, is dedicated.

2009

Left the PCUSA and joined the EPC.

2019

Faith Hall renovation is completed.

2020

Church became debt-free.

2024

Children's Wing and Common Area refresh is completed.

Known for its lush greenways, Southern hospitality and exquisite experiences with the arts, *Germantown blends graciousness with forward-thinking vision.*

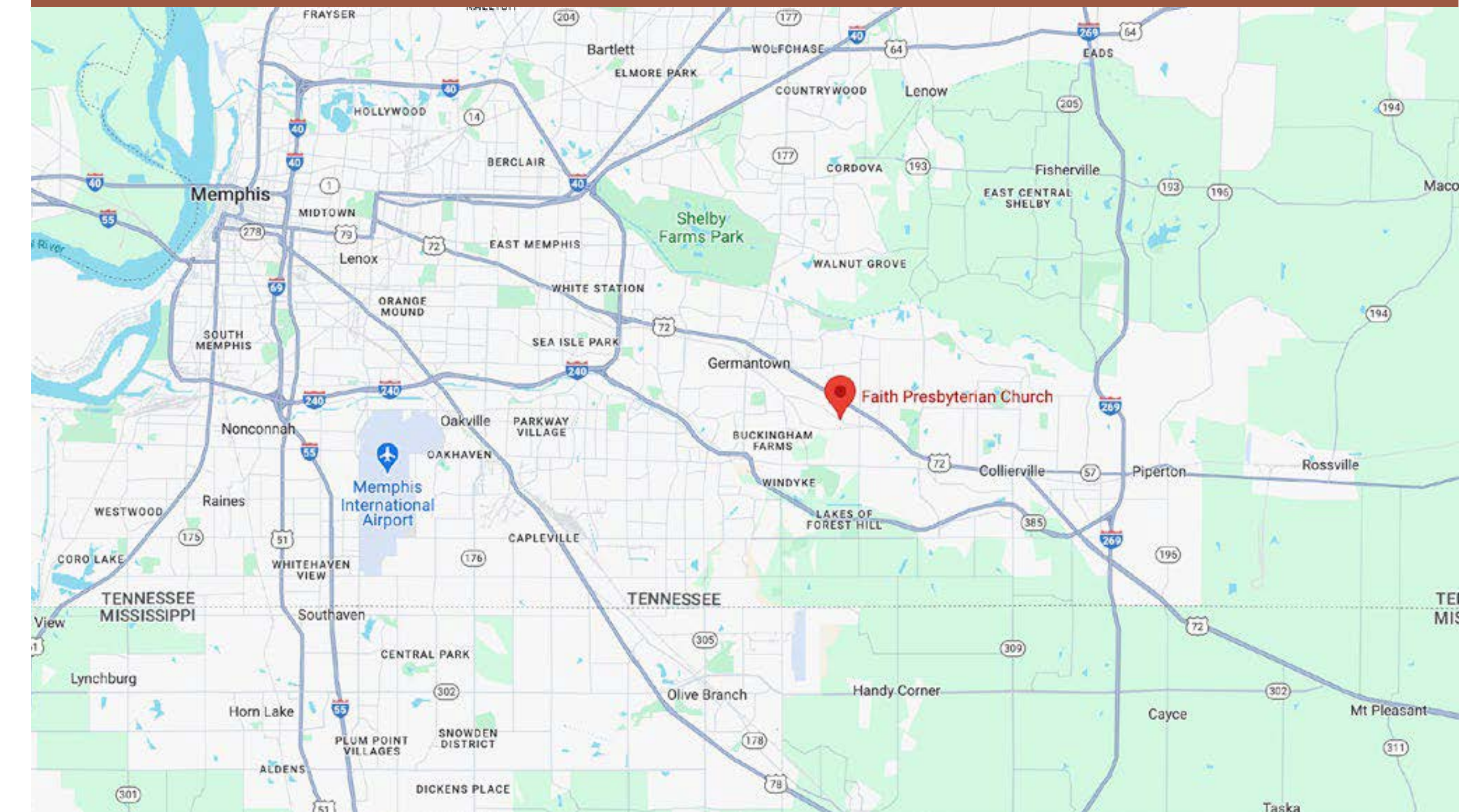
