

PASTOR JOB DESCRIPTION PART TIME

PURPOSE

To shepherd the flock of God, by proclaiming Christ, Admonishing every person and teaching every person with all wisdom so that we may present every person complete in Christ.

SKILLS AND TRAINING

- Able to articulate doctrine, the gospel, and spiritual concepts
- Must have a thorough knowledge of the Bible
- Has been called by God for this role in the church, and has been gifted by God for this role
- Has been accepted by the local Presbytery of the EPC to serve as a pastor in the church

DUTIES

- Preach the Word to motivate believers to love and good works. Lead Sunday worship with 6 Sundays off per year for leave / vacation.
- Preaching shall primarily be expository striving to cover the entire word of God
- Provide for the spiritual care of the congregation at death, baptisms, weddings, regular communion, serious health counsel/comfort, and etc.
- Provide for discipline when needed.
- Provide for administrative connection with Presbytery.

THEOLOGY Our pastor must believe in:

2 Salvation is by Faith Alone

3 Salvation is by Grace Alone
