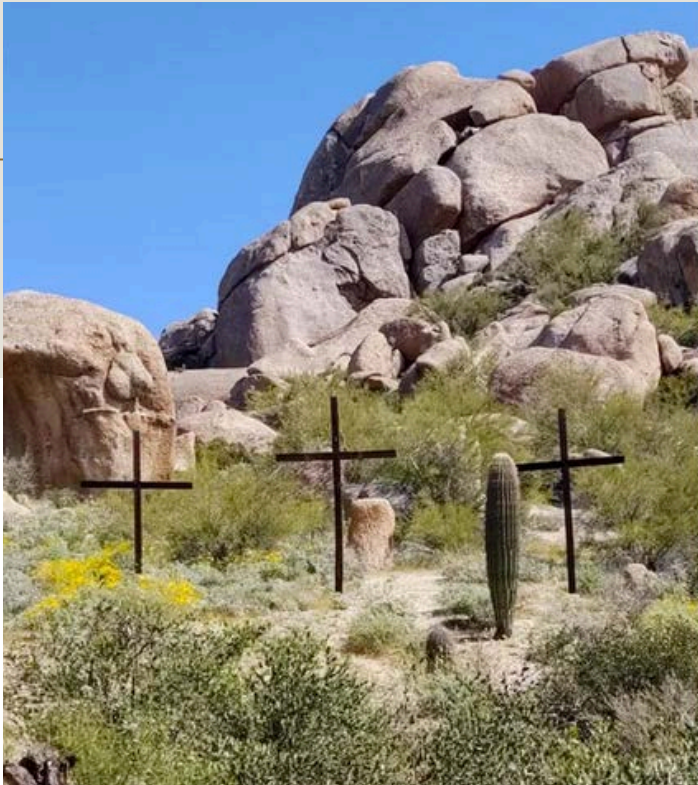

Located in North Scottsdale, Arizona,

Desert Hills has been ministering to the Cave Creek, Carefree, North Scottsdale, and North Phoenix communities for over fifty years. Our lovely sanctuary hosts two traditional Sunday services and overlooks the dramatic granite formation next to The Boulders Golf Resort.

Our Fellowship Center, completed in 2008, contains a full commercial kitchen and numerous meeting and classrooms.

An inspirational Memorial Garden is located between the two buildings “under the rocks.” The buildings and land are wholly-owned and debt-free.

Led for twenty years by Senior Pastor Jim Noble, this Egalitarian, Evangelical Presbyterian Church congregation draws from the surrounding communities of Cave Creek, Carefree, North Phoenix, and North Scottsdale.

Desert Hills Presbyterian Church is an active church with numerous groups and activities including men's, women's, and community Bible studies, covenant groups, dinner groups, prayer groups, grief support groups and youth and children's activities. Local Music and Arts

In addition to the local Arts at the Rocks performances on our campus, Phoenix is home to The Phoenix Symphony, Arizona Opera, Ballet Arizona, Phoenix Art Museum and Musical Instrument Museum (MIM) which hosts concerts from jazz to classical.

Sporting Events

In spring, catch a Cactus League spring training game at a local field around the valley. Other local teams include Arizona Diamondbacks, Arizona Cardinals, Phoenix Suns and Arizona Coyotes.
