- Our Location. The Fair Oaks community has a unique suburban and semi-rural composition, with great schools, a quaint village center and winding paths along the famous American River (down river from where Gold was discovered in 1848). We enjoy a cost of living that is 14% below the state average.
- Our Campus. Fair Oaks Church is located on eleven beautiful acres of oak studded land on top of a hill adjacent to a large community park and public library. Our campus footprint is on two acres of the land with a large, worship center, a multi-use conference facility, and a Kids and Youth building built in 2014.
