7 Year Plan

3 Year Goals

Have two discipling communities established outside of Somerset proper.
Identify and be equipping young leaders
Move the 40% participations rate we have outside of worship to 60% participation outside of worship.
Identify an individual in each of the discipling communities established to serve as a resource liaison for those in crises and brokenness that we meet.

Places to Start in this first year

Seek to get staff and structure in place to support vision and goals.
Create and implement training and equipping for disciple-making into the structures of Session, Deacons, Teams, Sunday school, Crossroads, Mission Opportunities, etc.
Develop the means to consistently communicate the vision and goals of St. Paul's moving forward.
Begin to identify and invite servant leaders to participate in the discipling communities that will be established outside of Somerset proper.
