

Welcome to the beautiful Columbia Basin of Washington State.



Ephrata, WA is the Grant County seat and gateway to the Columbia Basin. There are about 12,000 people living in the town and surrounding agricultural areas. Ephrata is located in central Washington, a three hour drive from Seattle-Tacoma International Airport and a two hour drive from Spokane. I-90 makes access easy to both ends of the state. Wenatchee is a major shopping hub, less than an hour's drive away. This is an agricultural region and is near 144 lakes, many canyons, mountains and recreational opportunities along the Columbia River. Though agriculture drives much of the economic base, there are a high number of professional people working and living in Ephrata because of the Public Utility District, Grant County Seat and the Federal Bureau of Reclamation. Big Bend Community College is in Moses Lake (population 22,000) and is 20 minutes away. Ephrata School District is known for high levels of excellence in all the schools. With abundant sunshine and four seasons, this is an ideal location for outdoor recreation like hiking, fishing, hunting, and watersports. Please see the CIF and Job Description.
