Fremont seeks a person of character, integrity, and spiritual maturity to serve Jesus in a full-time position as the Minister to Students and Families, with a passion and vision for teenagers.

### **Church Description**

Located in Sacramento, California for over 140 years, Fremont is an Evangelical Presbyterian Church committed to a full and diverse set of ministries, including long-standing music, youth and children's programs, which continue to attract large numbers of community members. Both classic and modern worship services are offered on Sunday mornings. We seek to maximize the opportunity God has given us to create space for people to become lifelong followers of Jesus Christ and to relentlessly pursue His transformation of our neighborhood, city, and world.

### **Primary Position Responsibilities**

- Create and implement a ministry program that includes youth groups, Bible studies, special events, mission trips, and leadership development that emphasize discipleship and outreach
- Serve as lead teacher for student ministry programs
- Recruit, equip, and encourage volunteer leaders to assist in the program and develop relationships with students
- Develop an active discipleship program for students and volunteer staff
- Work in coordination with the supervisor to manage program budget and set long-range goals
- Participate in regular church staff meetings and provide leadership where appropriate
- Develop ministries that address the needs of students and families

- Creative energy and drive to lead ministries that are unique and attractive to students
- Demonstrated ability to develop scripture-based lessons and applications to the challenging world in which youth live
- Character and integrity that serve as a positive role model for the students at Fremont and the city of Sacramento
- Commitment to discipling students and the desire to walk beside them as they grow in their faith
- Passion for developing leaders to disciple and mentor students
- Public presence that models leadership, positive communication, and understanding
- Ability to develop and articulate a vision for a vibrant, inspirational, and thriving student ministry program that is consistent with the vision of the church
- Support organized implementation of events and programs

- Possess at least five years experience in youth ministry leadership and a bachelor's degree (applicable ministry experience, both paid and volunteer, can be substituted in some cases); some basic theological education is desirable
