Harvest Church Music & Worship Coordinator

Church Profile: Harvest Church is one year old and is a Mission Church in the Evangelical Presbyterian Church (EPC) denomination. As a mission church, Harvest is currently led by a leadership team known as the Launch Team under the direction of a Transitional Church Planter. Within the next year, Harvest will move from being a Mission Church to being a fully established church, known in the EPC as a Local Church. The leadership of the Launch Team will be replaced by congregationally elected Elders, known as Ruling Elders. The transitional church planter will be replaced by a permanent pastor, known as a Teaching Elder. Combined, the Teaching Elder and the Ruling Elders will comprise what is known as a Session that will assume leadership and governance of the congregation.

Harvest Church is committed to the authority of the Holy Scriptures, the Bible. That commitment is reflected in all aspects of Harvest's ministry from preaching to teaching to worship to small groups to missions to youth ministry to children's ministry to outreach to evangelism and beyond. Harvest is a Great Commandment/Great Commission church that is reformed in its theology and presbyterian in its form of government. The central theology of the EPC can be found under *Essentials of the EPC*. These Essentials serve as a Statement of Faith for Harvest Church.

Worship is centered on bringing glory to God, bringing spiritual growth and strength to the congregation, and bringing the saving message of Jesus Christ to the community. In broad strokes, the musical style is a combination of the "contemporary" music that was birthed in the latter 20th century and the "traditional" church music found in classic hymnody.

Harvest Church is now ready to bring a Music & Worship Coordinator on staff part-time. The following information outlines the expectations incumbent upon the person who fills that position.

Title: Music & Worship Coordinator

Duties:

Collaborate and coordinate with the Pastor to plan and lead Sunday service music and selected worship elements.

Collaborate and coordinate with the Pastor to plan and lead special service music and selected worship elements. Special services include seasonal services such as those that occur during the Christmas and Easter seasons and other special events/occasions as they occur.

Recruit, develop, and rehearse musicians and singers, and lead musicians, singers, and the congregation during regular worship services and special services.

Report to the Pastor for ongoing supervision.

Qualifications:

Strong Christian beliefs that are compatible with the theology of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church (EPC), represented succinctly by the EPC Essentials which serve as the Statement of Faith of Harvest Church.

Skilled singer and instrumentalist (piano and/or guitar) with a comfortable up-front presence.

3-5 years of experience as a music and worship leader or (minimally) 3-5 years of experience as a member of a skilled music and worship team accompanied by a positive recommendation from that team's music and worship leader.

Familiar and comfortable with worship music repertoire from standard hymns to early contemporary praise music (70s plus) to recent contemporary praise music (2000s).

A minimum of 3 favorable references.

Compensation/Scope: \$12,000 - \$15,000 annual salary depending on skill and experience. Part-Time ~ 7-10 hours/week. Must be present 48 Sundays/year and for all special seasonal/holiday services.
