

Pastoral Resident

Purpose of the position: This is a 1-3 year¹ developmental track, focusing in the areas of preaching/teaching, pastoral care, and spiritual leadership, for men² actively pursuing a career in pastoral ministry. Candidates must either be currently pursuing or have recently completed an MDiv. While this is a full-time position, 15 hours each week will be dedicated to study – either for MDiv work, sermon prep, biblical counseling training, etc. Residents will also qualify for staff educational assistance which may be used to offset the cost of seminary. At the end of the residency, employment with Gateway Church will end and the Resident will be "sent" to serve a church in need of a pastor, preferably within our Evangelical Presbyterian Church denomination.

Responsibilities:

- Continuing Education 15 hours a week

 - Year 1: 4-6x

 - Year 3: 25+ (10 at Gateway; rest filling other church pulpits)

² Because Gateway Church is complementarian in our theology, this position is only available to males who are actively pursuing a career in pastoral ministry.

³ Staff Educational Assistance and/or Knox Seminary Scholarship funds will be available to help offset seminary costs.

- Year 2: 4-6x times:
- Year 3: 15+ (10 at Gateway; rest filling other church pulpits)
- Session/leadership development
 - o Year 1: attend
 - Year 2: lead prayer
 - Year 3: lead study
- Care/counseling
 - Year 1: shadow visits and counseling sessions;
 - Year 2: do care and counseling with observation;
 - Year 3: care and counseling without observation
- Membership & Baptism classes
 - Year 1: observe only
 - Year 2: split responsibilities 50/50
 - Year 3: staff member observes and gives feedback but resident leads class
- Active presbytery participant
- Other duties as assigned by Senior Pastor and/or Executive Director
