- Cultivate a culture of generosity within the church community, inspiring individuals to give generously of their time, talents, and financial resources.
- Develop innovative strategies to educate and empower members of our community to embrace stewardship as a fundamental aspect of their faith journey.

#### Fundraising

- Oversee fund reporting processes, providing transparent and accountable stewardship of all financial resources entrusted to the church.
- Ensure that donors are well-informed about the utilization and impact of their gifts, in alignment with Hope Church's values of integrity and transparency.

- Collaborate with church leadership to integrate stewardship and development initiatives into the overall ministry strategy of Hope Church.
- Provide mentorship and guidance to staff and volunteers involved in stewardship and fundraising efforts, nurturing a team committed to excellence and service.
